What is Autism?

Autism is a life long condition which can affect a persons ability to communicate appropriately, to think flexibly and to develop social relationships. Communication is affected both verbally and non-verbally, for example not understanding facial expressions or social cues. They also commonly have sensory difficulties, such as a sensitivity to noise, smells or touch.

Autism is a spectrum condition, which means it can range from moderate to severe and it can affect anyone, whether or not they have a learning disability.

It is estimated there are more than 8,500 people with Autism in Berkshire. If you include their direct family, this number trebles to over 25,000 people affected directly by Autism on a daily basis.
