How you can help

There are many ways in which you can help raise valuable funds so that BAS can continue to offer support for children, adults and their families affected by autistic spectrum disorders.

Simple and easy.....	And a bit more active.....
<p>Ask your child's school if they will hold a dress down day or an event to raise funds for BAS. Nominate BAS as a beneficiary of school and parents' association events such as sponsored walks and balls.</p> <p>Collect inkjet cartridges and used stamps.</p> <p>If you belong to a club or to an organisation such as Lions, Round Table, Ladies Circle, Rotary or Inner Wheel, ask if they will support BAS by making a donation or holding an event.</p> <p>Put BAS's name forward as Charity of the Year at your workplace, church, club, child's school.</p> <p>Find a site for a collecting box.</p> <p>Organise a party plan evening in your home and donate the proceeds.</p> <p>Help sell our Christmas cards.</p> <p>Use our webshops and tell your friends about them. Get the club's support for a charity match.</p> <p>Hold a dress down day at work.</p> <p>Find out what your company does to support charities. If, for example, it runs team building events or makes a donation in lieu of Christmas cards, please put BASs name forward.</p>
