



## Welcome to the BAS Speaker Meeting!

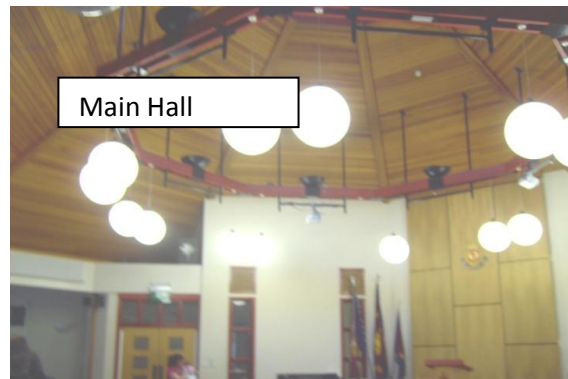
If you are on the Autistic Spectrum and would like any help please ask one of the BAS helpers (we have name badges on like this).



- Welcome to the Salvation Army Church in Lower Earley.



- The BAS meeting is in the Main Hall. Come through the entrance doors and turn left. The main door into the hall is further along to the right.



- Refreshments are available before the meeting – there is a serving hatch in the main hall.



- Books are on sale before and after the talk – in the hall where the meeting is held. If you want any help with choosing books or paying for books, please ask one of the BAS helpers. You can pay by cash or cheque.
- You may sit on any of the chairs laid out in rows in the room. If you want help with seating please ask a BAS helper.
  - If you would like somewhere quiet to sit until the meeting starts, please ask one of the BAS helpers. One of them will collect you when the talk is due to start.
  - The speaker will be by the entrance nearest to the serving hatch and may show slides. They will probably invite the audience to ask questions at the end.



- The toilets are to the left off the entrance hall.
- The talk should start at 7.30. We will let you know if it will be late. One of the BAS helpers will start the meeting off by introducing the speaker so you will know that it has started.
- The talk should finish by 9.00.
- We ask everyone to leave the room by 9.30 although sometimes people are still in the room then. We have to empty the room by 10.00 as the centre closes then.
